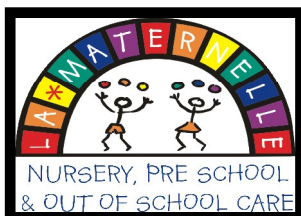

Invoices & Payments

We invoice for permanent sessions in advance. For example your November invoice will be for all your permanent sessions in November. Casual sessions can also be reserved subject to availability. These sessions up to and including the 25th of the month will be invoiced the following month. Therefore, any casual sessions reserved in November up to and including the 25th will be invoiced in December, any after the 25th will be invoiced in January.

Please note that all invoices should be paid during the first week of the month and late charges will apply if invoices are not paid for during the month for which they are issued. We hope you understand our reasons for this.
